Whether you're here for a short visit, or an extended stay with loved ones, OrbitProtect's Parent Boost Insurance is specifically designed to meet Immigration New Zealand's health insurance requirements under the Parent Boost Visa

This special visa was created to strengthen family connections while easing the demand on New Zealand's public health system. As part of the visa conditions, all holders must have eligible health insurance and that's where we come in.

Please note: Parent Boost does not cover routine medical care such as GP visits for minor or non-urgent conditions like coughs and colds.

Benefits Summary

The below table provides a summary of your cover, while you're in New Zealand. The limits apply to the policyholder and are based on a 365 day period from the policy start date.

IMPORTANT: The limits are based on a policy year from the policy start date. These limits apply regardless of how long your actual period of insurance is and how many separate policies you take out with us in a policy year. If you buy multiple short-term policies within a year, for example three policies for four months each, your benefit limit applies to the full 365-day period/policy year, not separately for each policy.



Your Benefits

Unexpected or Emergency Medical Treatment

If you need medical treatment for an unexpected or emergency medical event (excluding cancer), we'll cover your hospital related costs while you're admitted to hospital. This includes your hospital stay, any required surgeries, specialist consultations, anaesthesiology fees, tests and medications.

After a hospital stay, we will also cover you for GP or nurse practitioner follow ups, and lab tests for up to six months.

We also cover your related out-of-hospital medical expenses including specialist consultations, diagnostic investigations and ambulance transfers.

Please note: For injuries that happen in New Zealand, you'll need to first lodge a claim with the Accident Compensation Corporation (ACC).

Unexpected or Emergency Cancer Treatment

If you need unexpected or emergency cancer treatment, we'll cover your cancer related costs. This includes your hospital stay, any required surgeries, chemotherapy, immunotherapy, radiotherapy, brachytherapy, specialist consultations, anaesthesiology fees, tests and medications.

After your initial treatment is complete and your condition is stable, you can choose to either remain in New Zealand for continuing cancer treatment or if you no longer meet Immigration New Zealand Acceptable Standard of Health, we will pay for your repatriation.

Ongoing Cancer Treatment

If you're diagnosed with cancer while in New Zealand, you may prefer to continue treatment here. We'll keep supporting you by covering cancer-related costs, plus physiotherapy after your treatment to help you recover.

Repatriation Cover

If you no longer meet the Acceptable Standard of Health (the standard you met to get the Parent Boost Visa), and you are fit to return to your home country we will pay your repatriation expenses.

You can nominate a family member to accompany you and we will pay for their return economy ticket, up to 10 nights of accommodation and reasonable meal expenses.

Bereavement Cover

In the unfortunate event that you pass away while in New Zealand, OrbitProtect offers compassionate support to help your loved ones during a difficult time.

We provide two options to honour you and your family's wishes:

1. Returning your remains to your home country

If your sponsoring child chooses to return your remains home, we'll cover the cost of repatriation.

This includes:

- Transportation of your remains.
- A return economy ticket for a nominated family member and up to five nights' accommodation and reasonable meal expenses.

OR

Funeral cover in New Zealand

If your sponsoring child prefers for you to be laid to rest in New Zealand, we'll contribute towards the funeral, cremation, or burial expenses.

Pre-Existing Medical Conditions

Pre-existing medical conditions aren't automatically covered under emergency or cancer-related claims – but you can apply to have them considered.

Here's how it works:

- Pay a one-time, non-refundable assessment fee of NZ\$45.00
- We'll review your medical history
- If approved, your cover will be confirmed in writing on your certificate of insurance after payment of any additional premium

Pre-existing conditions are defined as: conditions that exist prior to your policy start date. This includes any sign, symptom, or condition:

- that the policyholder is aware of; or
- that the policyholder is taking ongoing medication for; or
- medical attention or treatment has been sought or given; or
- that a reasonable person in the same circumstances would be expected to be aware of, even if no formal diagnosis or treatment has yet occurred.

If any new medical conditions arise while you're covered under the Parent Boost plan, they won't be automatically included in future OrbitProtect policies.

To ensure continued coverage, these conditions must be:

- Fully re-disclosed to us; and
- If approved, your cover will be confirmed in writing on your certificate of insurance after payment of any additional premium.

14-day free look period

If you change your mind within 14 days of purchase and haven't made a claim, you're entitled to a full refund - no questions asked.
