

As an RSE worker in New Zealand, you're required to have health insurance and the cost of this insurance is taken out of your pay automatically. This insurance helps cover costs if you get hurt or sick while in New Zealand and need to see a doctor.

Your OrbitPay card

You will get an OrbitPay card with your insurance. Please keep it safe, so you can use it again if you return next season.

You can use this card to help pay for treatment when you see a doctor if you get hurt or sick while you are working in New Zealand.
